Grants, Contracts, & Scholarships

Grants and contracts provide additional revenue streams, and scholarships increase access to education & training.

Grants & Contracts

- CDC National Center for Emerging and Zoonotic Infectious Diseases (NCEZID) Cooperative Agreement – allowed ADS to host the 2nd Antibiotic Stewardship Summit in 2024 and provide free access to the on-demand recordings
- CDC Division of Oral Health (5-year contract) – ADS hosted 3 listening sessions to provide feedback to CDC on guidelines and existing CDC resources, as well as provide a team of subject matter experts to assist with updates to CDC's Foundations training
- National Indian Health Board (NIHB) – a partnership to produce and host the 2023 Tribal Infection Control Boot Camp in Vancouver, WA, from September 19 – 21.
- OSHA Susan Harwood Training Program Grant – awarded for 2023 – 2024. Developed a free, 3-hour instructor-led training program targeting tribally operated healthcare facilities - we exceeded our goal and trained 373 people across the country! ADS was awarded this grant again for 2024 – 2025.

Scholarships

- ADS-DANB-DALE Foundation Andrew Whitehead Education and Certification Scholarship – removes financial barriers to help dental professionals access IPC education and certification (awarded 45 scholarships in 2024)
- Henry Schein Cares Scholarship – provides underserved public health dental professionals with Boot Camp registration fee assistance (awarded 50 scholarships in 2024)
- Anna Nelson, CDA, RDA, MA Scholarship – provides dental assistants with Boot Camp registration fee assistance (awarded 25 scholarships in 2024)
